

Monthly Board Meeting
PARTRIDGE TOWNSHIP
June 1, 2022

Chairman, Matt Klocke called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Those present were David Durheim, Ovid Jensen, Matt Klocke and Anne Stitt, Laurie Jorgensen attended via Zoom. Minutes of the last Board Meeting were read. Matt asked if any objections or corrections to the minutes, none being stated they were approved as read. Treasurer's report was read. Beginning balance \$265,590.10 the receipts totaled \$222.36 and disbursements of \$3,424.26, to bring our ending balance to \$262,388.20. Matt asked if there are any objections or corrections to the treasurer's report, none being stated, treasurer's report was approved as read. Claims to be paid tonight 7785 to 7796, with check 7790 not being used.

Old Business:


- Gravel was put on the roads as planned, this gravel was purchased through Robert's Excavating and out of Gary Kolands' pit, it was much better than the gravel last year. Seems to have cut down the slippery, muddy substance.
- Ovid attended the Blue Zone Community meeting, they want people to be back to gathering the communities, old family core and social groups to bring a strong community based. They state that having that promotes healthier living.
- Discussion was held on Klier permit. They have been having communication issues with the Zoning Administrator. They spoke to David and was asking about the frost-free footing requirements as they were told to do what they needed to and then it would be checked out. Sounds like they are using pilasters which will be at least 4 feet deep, so that is good. Also, they have another dwelling that will be removed, this was not noted on the permit so David has asked them to sign something stating that will happen and they said they would.
- Clerk drafted a letter to William Carr Trustee 70523 Hwy 23 regarding the west side of the property needing ditching on Elwell Road, supervisors approved and it will be mailed with a response requested either way.


New Business:

- Linda Henrikson contacted David Durheim via phone and email. She is update that the road grader is throwing road rock on her lawn about 3-4'. She stopped Jesse when he was out grading and he said it couldn't be helped. She wants to know if he could throw the rock the other way instead of into her yard. Or if the township could buy and Echo rock rake with the rubber paddles and come back in the spring and rake the rocks off, or borrow it to her to do. After discussion about this it was decided that no action would be taken, the rocks would be within the road right of way and the Township would not be required to do anything differently.
