

Monthly Board Meeting  
PARTRIDGE TOWNSHIP  
February 1, 2023

Chairman, Matt Klocke called the meeting to order at 7:20 p.m, following the adjournment of the Board of Review meeting. Those present were Laurie Jorgensen, David Durheim, Ovid Jensen, Matt Klocke and Anne Stitt. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the last Board Meeting were read. Matt asked if any objections or corrections to the minutes, none being stated they were approved as read. Treasurer's report was read. Beginning balance \$351,184.75 the receipts totaled \$1,597.70 and disbursements of \$9,594.67, to bring our ending balance to \$343,187.78. Matt asked if there are any objections or corrections to the treasurer's report, none being stated, treasurer's report was approved as read. Claims to be paid tonight are 7845 to 7848.

Old Business:

- David sent a certified letter to Linda Hendriksen to address the branches from her trees causing issues in the right of way to our contractor's equipment.
- Tony Ecklund is representing Partridge Township on the North Pine Area Hospital District. Clerk will update the website to replace Myrna Nelson with Tony Ecklund.
- Clerk spoke with Denise at the Sheriff's office about the funding for clean up from the December heavy snow storms. Partridge has been added to the list, and now has to secure an estimate of clean up expenses. Road inspection will be done on Thursday 2/16 at 3:00, clerk will post at the Town Hall that there will be a quorum present.
- David gathered some information on Nuisance Ordinance and remedies, he spoke with County Attorney, Reese and Pine County Zoning Officer Caleb. Both are willing to come to further meetings to discuss enforcement, what County and other Townships are doing. David is going to continue gather more information for the Supervisors to review.
- Discussion held on Fire Contract, several questions. Clerk will contact the City Clerk, Kathy and ask that we be put on the Agenda for the City Council meeting 2/8. Supervisors and Clerk will attend. Clerk will forward questions/thoughts to the City in advance.

New Business:

- Election Judges are set for March 14 Township Election. Connie Ecklund, Joyce Larsen and Anne Stitt will work the Election which is 5pm to 8 pm.
- Discussion held on a CD offer from Northview Bank for a 13 month period where they are offering 4.06%, this would allow the Township to earn more interest than what the Bank Account is currently making. Ovid made a motion to move \$200,000.00 into a Certificate of Deposit for the 13 months, David made a second. Motion carried 3-0.
