

Monthly Board Meeting

July 5, 2023

Chairman, Matt Klocke called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Present were Matt Klocke, Scott Peterson, David Durham, Laurie Jorgensen and Anne Stitt. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the last Board Meeting were read. Scott said he had corrections to the minutes; the City of Askov puts on the National Night Out, not the Askov Fire Relief, and that there was a stipulation if Partridge Township makes a donation that we get some sort of recognition that the Township is a contributor, Scott then made a motion to accept the minutes as presented with corrections noted above, 2nd by David, motion carried 3-0. Treasurer's report was read. Beginning balance \$102,338.67, receipts totaled \$75,382.56 and disbursements of \$20,052.55, for ending balance to \$157,668.68. Motion by Scott to accept the Treasurer's Report, 2nd by David, motion carried 3-0. Claims to be paid tonight are 7881 & 7883.

Old Business:


