

Monthly Board Meeting  
PARTRIDGE TOWNSHIP  
May 3, 2023

Chairman, Matt Klocke called the meeting to order at 7:39 p.m, following the Road Inspection. Present were Matt Klocke, Scott Peterson, David Durheim, Laurie Jorgensen and Anne Stitt. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the last Board Meeting were read. Scott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by David, motion carried 3-0. Treasurer's report was read. Beginning balance \$111,541.27, receipts totaled \$109.61 and disbursements of \$9,475.76, for ending balance to 102,175.12. Motion by Scott to accept the Treasurer's Report, 2<sup>nd</sup> by David, motion carried 3-0. Claims to be paid tonight are 7865 & 7866.

- Road Inspection was completed prior to this meeting, notes will be typed up by the Clerk and attached to these minutes.
- Matt spoke with Terry Johnsen who is willing to be on the Planning Commission to fill the vacancy created when Scott was elected to the Town Board. Matt made a motion to appoint Terry Johnsen to the Planning Commission, Scott made a second, motion carried 3-0.
- Laurie attended the Short Course in Duluth and brought back some information which she gave copies of to everyone.

New Business:

- Scott Peterson completed the Board of Appeal and Equalization training and is now certified through 7-1-2027. David is going to take his, Matt's expires this year so he will be taking as well. Clerk will forward the link to both Matt and David.
- Discussion was held on keeping up the Road Spreadsheet that Ovid had started, David said he could do that. Further discussion was held about getting someone to create a type of Database that we could load information into and it would be better for historic data.
- David was contacted by someone who wants to purchase property on Clark Road and then split, it was decided the best route was to send them a copy of the Zoning Ordinance and refer them to the land split portion so they can read that and know what is allowed.
- Discussion held on options to get gravel this year, North Pine has adjusted the screens and their gravel is much better, Scott will talk with Dennis and see if the Township purchases gravel from them if our contractor can haul it out of their pit.
