

Monthly Board Meeting

September 6, 2023

Chairman, Matt Klocke called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Matt Klocke, Scott Peterson, Sandy Gebhart, Askov City Council, Laurie Jorgensen and Anne Stitt. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes of the last Board Meeting were approved as read. Matt asked if any objections/corrections, none being stated approved as read. Treasurer's report was read. Beginning balance \$134,641.99, receipts totaled \$261.97 and disbursements of \$13,031.00, for ending balance to \$121,872.96. Matt asked if any objections/corrections, none being stated approved as presented. Claims to be paid tonight are 7884, 7889 to 7891.

Special Visitors:

- Sandy Gebhart, City of Askov Council Member and Public Safety Officer discussed the fire contract. The City is thinking about a 5% inflation rate. Scott Peterson said that the Township had brought up a 3 year contract at the last meetings held at the City of Askov and the Township would like to pursue that. Discussion was held about the increase and the Township felt that 3% increase each year for the next 3 years would be more feasible. Sandy said that she would take this information back to her City Council and let us know if they would accept the 3 year contract with a 3% inflation increase. She will report back to us the decision or if further negotiations are needed.
