Monthly Board Meeting PARTRIDGE TOWNSHIP January 6, 2021 Virtual Meeting via Zoom

Ovid Jensen called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Those present were Ovid Jensen, Lee Johnsen, Matt Klocke, Laurie Jorgensen, Dan Taylor, Stefanie Youngberg and Anne Stitt. Minutes of the last Board Meeting were read. Ovid asked if any objections or corrections to the minutes, none being stated, minutes are approved as read. Treasurer's report was read. We had a beginning balance of \$259,955.92 the receipts totaled \$4,204.88, and disbursements of \$15,912.18, to bring our ending balance to \$248,248.62. We have one outstanding check in the amount of \$375.00. Bank balance is \$248,623.62. Ovid asked if there are any objections or corrections to the treasurer's report, none being stated, treasurer's report was approved as read. Claims to be paid tonight 7699-7707, all claims approved verbally and will be signed at next in person meeting.

Special Visitors:

- Dan Taylor wanted to talk about Low Landing Road, said his parents have owned this land the last 15 years, Parcel ID 250204001, there are swells and dips in road, what if anything can the Township do to fill it in. If you are going slow it is ok in a truck. Ovid said since the Township has not maintained a road in 6 years there is not a responsibility for the Township to maintain the road and that we aren't looking to take on more roads. Dan asked if nothing can be done if the land owners can have permission to make improvements, Ovid said they would not need our permission as it isn't a Township Road. Dan said that they built a new cabin there and was hoping something could be done. Ovid said we will look at it during our spring road inspection and get in touch but again we are not looking to take on any new roads for maintenance.
- Stefanie Youngberg received our letter, spoke w/Clerk and then talked with Zoning Administrator Kathy Morris and Planning Commission Scott Peterson and they had suggested an interim use permit. Stefanie knows they are not in compliance with the Zoning Ordinance and wants to rectify that, they would like 30 months to return that dwelling in question back to a shop w/ gaming room upstairs. She apologized for not doing it right away when they built their house and wants to know if there is any middle ground. We have not adopted the new Zoning Ordinance with IUP language, so that isn't an option, there is nothing in the Variance or CUP language that they would meet. The Board will discuss and get back to them shortly.

Old Business:

- Roberts Excavating had the brushing on Pickeral Creek, they will do ditching in the spring. Prairie Lane was done also, but Steve Fahlman's trees were not touched.
- Discussion was held on the Youngberg's, Matt reviewed the Zoning Ordinance for an hour and agrees that there is nothing in the language that would allow them to do CUP, or variance, nor the IUP in the Zoning Ordinance that has been proposed to the Board. Decision to ask the Youngberg's sign a notice stating something like: We, Dennis and Stefanie Youngberg understand that we are not in compliance with the Partridge Township Zoning Ordinance, we intend to turn the 1st dwelling built on our property into a shop as was the agreement when we were approved the Building permit for our current home. We have an occupant and once this current occupant moves out or 30 months whichever is less, we will return the 1st building to a heated wood shop with a gaming room upstairs for the kids. Ovid asked the clerk to send this information to the Planning Commission Members to get their feedback.

New Business:

- Filing for Candidacy is open now, Supervisor, Matt Klocke is up for election and Treasurer, Laurie Jorgensen, they both are going to file again and Clerk will email them the Affidavit to File form which they will complete and return within the timeline. No one else has expressed interest. Filing period is 12/29/2020 to 01/12/2021.
- Board of Audit is 02/03/2021 at 6:30 p.m.
- The Board has decided to move forward with the changes recommended by the Planning Commission, they will hold a Public Hearing on March 3, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.
