Beginning balance \$90,333.11, receipts totaled \$103.04 & disbursements of \$19,739.29 for ending balance of 70,696.86. Outstanding checking of 102.91 so bank balance is \$70,799.77. CD balance is \$153,230.91. David made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as read, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Scott, motion carried 3-0.

Old Business:


- Progress is being made on Draeger Property on Root Road, they have hauled off the TV's and started tearing down some of the mobile home.

New Business:


- Pine County Township Officer's Association meeting is Saturday 10/26 at the Hinckley Community Center at 9:00 a.m.
