

ANNUAL MEETING
PARTRIDGE TOWNSHIP
March 10, 2026

The Clerk called the annual meeting to order at 8:08. Those present were David Durheim, Ovid Jensen, Cindy Durheim, Tony Ecklund, Scott Peterson, Gary Stitt, and Anne Stitt.

Pledge of Allegiance recited. Motion made by David Durheim to have Gary Stitt to act as moderator, 2nd by Ovid Jensen. Motion Carried.

Minutes of the 2025 Annual Meeting were read, Moderator asked for any additions or corrections, none being stated Minutes approved as read.

Election results were as follows: Total of 28 Ballots cast, Supervisor: Scott Peterson received 28 votes. The treasurer's report was read. We had a beginning balance \$103,670.26, Ending Balance was \$103,601.00 then a check had to be voided and reissued in 2026 for \$69.26 for the difference, receipts totaled \$226,056.01 and disbursements of \$157,766.57, ending balance of 2025 to \$171,959.70. CD balance was \$154,854.53 plus interest of \$6,386.07 for an ending balance of \$161,240.60; for a total combined balance of \$333,200.30. Opened up for questions, none were asked. Moderator asked if they were any additions or corrections, none being stated Treasurer's report was approved as read.

Business from the floor:

Road Report

There were no big road projects this year, there was ditch cleaning on Adolf Road, on Mulling Road there was some gravel spread after big rocks that were popping through were jack hammered down. Ovid asked about if road brushing was continuing, David said yes Brandon Melzark is following the 1/3 of Township each year on rotation to keep everything brushed. Ovid asked about where Township is getting the gravel, currently through North Pine they did adjust their screen size so the gravel is closer to what we desire, the Township will not purchase gravel from the Zaudtke pit as it is a non-compliant gravel pit.

Presentation and approval of the levy:

Discussion was held on the rate of inflation, and the fact that we did increase the levy last year. The Board at the Board of Review meeting had come up with a suggestion to keep the levy the same for this year. The consensus was to leave the levy as presented which was the same as last year. Ovid Jensen made a motion to accept the levy as below for a total of \$194,500.00, Tony Ecklund made a Second. Motion carried 7-0.

General: \$30,000.00

Road & Bridge: \$125,000.00

Fire: \$34,000.00

Zoning: \$5,500.00


Tuesday 3/9/2027 from 5 to 8pm is next year's Township Election and Annual Meeting will begin once election process is complete.
